Brief Summary of Rules:

Please refer to www.nadac.com for a full explanation of all NADAC rules and up to date information.

- Please note that NADAC trials should provide a safe and fun environment for both exhibitors and their dogs.
- Aggressive dogs will not be tolerated and will be excused from the trial.
- The show committee has the right to refuse any entry. Anyone not currently in good standing with NADAC will not be allowed to enter this trial.
- Exhibitors, through submission of entry, acknowledge that they are knowledgeable of NADAC rules and regulations, and agree to abide by all rules in effect at the time of this trial.
- No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reasons of riots, civil disturbances, fire, acts of God, public emergency, an act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee.
- Checks not honored by the bank do not constitute a valid entry fee. There will be a \$25.00 service charge for bank returned checks.
- Dog must be registered and have a valid registration number before entries will be accepted. <http://nadac.com/afm/dogregfrm.asp> A copy of the current Exhibitors Handbook may be downloaded free from the NADAC web site: www.nadac.com
- Bitches in heat, lame, or blind dogs are ineligible for entry, as is any dog with a deformity which may cause a judge to not be able to reasonably assess the dog's ability to function and perform agility obstacles safely, and in a manner that is in the best interest, health and welfare of the dog.
- No food, clickers, or other aids or devices shall be permitted on the course or within 10 feet of the ring. Food or a small non-audible toy can be in a secure container (ziplock bag is acceptable) in your pocket during your run but it cannot be used during your run, nor can you indicate to the dog it is there. Only Intro and Novice handlers may bring a non-audible toy into the ring for training purposes. They cannot earn a Qualifying score and must declare to the judge they are training before they commence their run. Please read the Exhibitor's Handbook for more information about toys and training in the ring.
- The sponsoring clubs will not be responsible for the loss or damage to any dog exhibited, or for the possessions of any exhibitor whether the result be accident or other cause. It is distinctly understood that every dog at this event is in the care and control of his owner or handler during the entire time the dog is on the show premises.

- 1.1. As used here "NADAC" means the North American Dog Agility Council, LLC., its members, officers, directors, employees, show chairs, show committees and agents.
- 1.2. Exhibitor/owner agree to abide by the rules and regulations of NADAC and any other rules and regulations appearing in the premium for this event.
- 1.3. Exhibitor/owner certify that the entered dog is not a hazard to persons, dogs or property and that the entered dog's rabies vaccination is current in accordance with the requirement of the state in which the dog resides.
- 1.4. Exhibitor/owner acknowledge all hazards presented by the event and the event premises, including, but not limited to, the condition of the surface, restrooms, security measures or lack of, electrical appliances, fittings, show rings, parking areas and the presence of unfamiliar animals and people; exhibitor and owner assume the risk of any harm arising from these.
- 1.5. Parking: Once you enter through the red gates at the end of our driveway please STAY to the right and park under the large tree ON OUR LAWN. Please try not to crowd each other or my house. WARNING!!!!!! YOUR GPS MAY TAKE YOU TO WRONG PLACE!!!! PLEASE USE DIRECTIONS AND LANDMARKS PROVIDED IN ORDER TO MAKE SURE YOU ARE IN THE CORRECT PLACE. OR CALL CAROLYN 701-321-0984

From the North: (Kansas City) US 69 south to KS 7 south to the town of Columbus. Turn right on US 160 west. continue straight through Oswego (4 way stop intersection). when coming out of town you will see Mid West Fertilizer on left, then Regional Veterinary Clinic, Golf course and Vail's Auto on right. DIRECTLY across from Vet clinic and Auto repair go left on 13000 road. Once on 13000 road you will IMMEDIATELY cross a set of Railroad tracks and the road turns to gravel. You will go 1.1 miles to our farm on right. our farm buildings and house are grey with red trim and sit up on a hill. You will enter through the two red gates at the end of our driveway.

From the East: US 160 west into Oswego and follow the above directions from the North.

From the South: -44 east take exit 289 go right on US 60/69/66 toward Vinita then right on OK-2 north. Once in Chetopa, KS go left on US 59 north. Once in Oswego go left on US 160/59 and follow the above directions from the North.

PLEASE be VERY vigilant when traveling our gravel road as Wheat harvest may possibly be in full swing. You very well might meet a tractor or combine on our road and please give them the right away if possible.

WORKERS: We need people to volunteer to work classes. We cannot hold a trial without help. Courses will be nested as much as they can, but we still need to change courses and bar set. Please help as best you can.

MORE INFO

The Trial is OUTDOORS in the beautiful country surrounded by farm fields. We will have a porta potty. We will have bleach, soap and water. We should have hand sanitizer but you are encouraged to bring your own.

The Covid situation of course means that things aren't going to be the usual "normal," so we need your help in keeping us all safe and to insure that we all have fun.

The Trial is indoors but the building is big. Social distancing is required and when unable to do so, wear a mask. Masks will be required for walk through and when social distancing cannot happen.

Throughout the trial: Social Distancing is a must. That includes in your crating area, waiting to enter the ring, after leaving the ring, at bathroom, picking up ribbons or looking at scores, during walk throughs and any other time we might have forgotten to mention. Masks must be worn during walk throughs.

If you are sick or have come into contact with someone that is sick, please stay home.

We also ask that, as stated in the waiver, if you do find that you have been in proximate contact with someone who has tested positive or who has the symptoms within the last 14 days, or you yourself have tested positive or are experiencing symptoms, please stay home, and contact us so we can withdraw your entry. You will receive FULL REFUND.

Leash Running: We are allowed to keep our leashes on person. It can be wrapped around your waist or shoulder just not your neck. You can also put leash in your pocket. As a club, we are required to have a leash runner if you do not want to do this. Please let me know if you need a leash runner by checking the box on the entry form. This way I can plan for having a worker for that class.

We will have a VERY brief "in person" briefing at 8 am each morning to address any last minute changes. But please limit your questions to only what is absolutely necessary. Please stay at least 6 feet (if not more) away from anyone else. Briefing notes will be send via email before the trial.

Ribbons will be self-serve. (a) please wait if someone is already at the table, please wait until they are through before you get yours. (b) please sanitize your hands both before and after getting your ribbons.

We of course need volunteers to make this trial run smoothly. If you are a bar setter volunteer, please bring your own lawn chair with you when you come into the ring, and take it when you leave.

The ring gates will be open unless you request otherwise. If you want them closed then ask the person in front of you to close the gate as they leave, and you close the entry gate as you enter.

Remember this is a Double Run Format Trial. We run the same course twice with no walk through in between. We will run EE OO NN for most classes except we will run EE ONON for Tunnelers and Touch N Go. You MAY (but do not have to) run the same dog twice in round 1 and then go get your other dog to run twice in round 2. Whatever works for you and your dog.

PLEASE TAKE YOUR TIME BETWEEN RUNS. WE WILL WAIT FOR YOU!!!!!!!!!!!! DO NOT RUSH YOURSELF OR YOUR DOG!!

If you contract COVID-19 within 2 weeks of attending the trial, please let me know.
